FREE SEA-NIC VIEWS OF THE PARADE OF SAIL

On Thursday, March 30 from 3-6 p.m., local residents can view the Parade of Sail for free from the downtown St. Pete waterfront, including premium viewing opportunities from the St. Pete Pier, Vinoy Park and Demens Landing Park.

Don't miss the chance to see and tour the historic boats that are part of this special event. All timed entry tickets must be purchased in advance at tallshipsstpete.com.

No walk-up tickets are available at the port during the festival.

KEEP CALM + TAKE A SHUTTLE

Event parking is not permitted at the Port. Festival organizers will have continuously running shuttles throughout the event between the South Core and Sundial parking garages.

- Handicapped parking is available in USF surface lots on the south side of 6th Avenue and 1st Street South, and at the Albert Whitted Park with continuous shuttle service to the port.**
- Guests coming from West Pinellas are encouraged to take the FREE Sun Runner service and exit at the Port St. Pete stop on 6th Avenue and 3rd Street South.**
- Tampa residents are encouraged to take the Cross-Bay Ferry where festival goers can take a shuttle from the ferry terminal to the port. Shuttle service to the ferry terminal will run through 10 p.m. on Friday and Saturday nights during the festival.**

DON'T ROCK THE BOAT (AND ADHERE TO SECURITY PRECAUTIONS)

Personal watercraft around the Parade of Sail or the Port should keep a safe distance and adhere to strict safety boundaries around the ships enforced by the coast guard and local law enforcement.

Festival organizers remind all mariners and recreational boaters watching or participating alongside the Parade of Sail on March 30, 2023, to be alert and aware of waterway conditions and be on the lookout for protected sealife.

PROHIBITED ITEMS ABOARD OUR SHIPS (AND DOCKS)

- **Increased security procedures are in place to enter the festival grounds.**
 - **All bags, backpacks and packages are subject to inspection prior to entering festival grounds.**
 - **All guests are subject to screening for prohibited items using hand-held metal detectors.**
- **The following items are not permitted:**
 - **Weapons, guns, knives or any other type of sharp objects**
 - **Disposable straws**
 - **Hard or soft coolers, luggage or bags with wheels**
 - **Any hazardous items or materials**
- **Any item that security deems unsafe or inappropriate will not be allowed inside festival grounds.**
- **Guests may bring in non-alcoholic beverages if it is in a factory sealed container.**
